

One of the many services provided by OMG Education is the delivery of an alternative education programme to young people between the ages of 14-18 years old in schools, prisons or at our Tower Hamlets centre.

The Programme provides young people with alternative learning methods to sustain in education or progress onto employment. Our high-quality teaching and learning programme will help them to achieve sustained progressions and life skills.

## **OUR STUDY PROGRAMME**

Our course of study is a 14-week programme, 5 days a week from 10am-3pm. The young person will engage in the following;

- Functional Skills Maths up to Level 2
- Functional Skills English up to Level 2
- Employability Skills up to Level 1
- Music or Creative Arts up to Level 1
- 1-2-1 Mentoring through the Programme
- Take part in a range of Personal Social and Development Workshops including;
  Confidence Building, Team Work, Gang Awareness and Conflict Resolution.

Upon assessment of the young person's progress, they may undertake a minimum 1 day to 4-week work placement.

We also provide additional options for the young person to stay on our education programme post the end of their 14-week programme, and can be tailored to the young person's specific needs. In partnership with the school or referrer we can discuss the best possible programme to ensure the young person's engagement.

Alternatively, we can put together a tailor-made programme specific to the needs of the young person, if our current programme does not meet the needs of the young person in question.







## This Programme is aimed to help us achieve the following;

- Re-engage the students that have low attendance or at risk of permenant exclusion
- Improve their academic attainment levels including their behaviour, confidence, self-esteem and Independent learning
- Through 1-2-1 Mentoring we set the young person clear goals and outcomes that they wish to achieve, not just on the course but throughout their lives
- Develop their employability skills
- Prepare them for the transition from Secondary School to post-16 education or employability.

## **Admissions and Induction**

It is important that we work harmoniously to achieve the best outcomes for the young people that are in our care, this is why the induction process is important to ensure a smooth transition for the young person onto our programme. We accept admissions throughout the course of the academic year as we offer a roll on-roll off process. As a referrer you will have to sign an agreement agreeing to a set of terms whilst the young person is with us.
